BUSINESS VISA REQUIREMENTS

- Citizens of Trinidad and Tobago and Barbados **do not** require a visa to enter Mexico for business purposes for less than 90 days.
 - Citizens of Suriname can apply directly at the Honorary Consulate of Mexico in Paramaribo, located at 15 Broostrat, Greyervnlijit, telephone +597-323-281.
 - All other nationalities please call the Consular Section to enquire if you require a visa to enter Mexico.

VISA APPLICATION PROCESS (for those nationalities who need one)

- A) Fill out the Application Form L1, downloadable from our web page www.mexico.tt.
 - B) Apply in person at the consular section of the Embassy of Mexico in Port of Spain, Trinidad and Tobago, from Monday to Friday, between 9:00 AM and 12:00 noon, with the following documentation:
 1. Passport with minimum validity of 6 months.
 2. Present one of the following documents:
 - a. Letter of invitation from a Chamber of Commerce or Industry; a Business Association; a Public or Private organization; an Industrial, Commercial or Financial Business or Institution in Mexico; or
 - b. Letter of appointment as representative from the foreign company, indicating responsibility for expenses during the stay in Mexico.
 3. One passport size photo (white background).
 4. Payment of a fee of TTD\$228.00. Exact amount will be appreciated.
 5. One photocopy of the following documents: main page of Passport, National ID, any former Mexican visa, valid visa from any other country, and any original document you want to keep.
 6. Proof of permanent or temporary legal residence will be necessary if you are not a citizen of Trinidad and Tobago or Suriname.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- Business Visas are given to people traveling to Mexico to find investment alternatives, make an investment or supervise it, represent a foreign company, make commercial transactions, or to attend assemblies or board meetings.
- If you plan to stay in Mexico for more than 6 months, you must present the following **additional** requirements to obtain an FM3 form:
 1. Two FM1 forms dully filled out, downloadable from our webpage www.mexico.tt, or directly at the Embassy of Mexico.
 2. Bring 6 passport size photos – 4 front and 2 right profile photos, in color, white background.
 3. Pay the equivalent of \$103.00 US dollars, exact amount.
- Mexican immigration authorities may require the documents presented at the consular section at the point of entry.
